This weekend is the collection for the Retired Priests fund. Priests do not usually have a large enough income to pay for a rest home and so the diocese will pick up the bill to give the appropriate care.

The GDPR legislation allows us to keep personal records for no more than five years although Churches can keep registers of Sacraments including Baptism, Confirmation, Marriage and the deceased. We keep records of first Communion too.

This is important as a record of living in the parish and practising here They are not obligatory but a good means to keep in contact. For children I would be grateful if the current year group was added, so those in year 2 can be invited to receive the sacraments of Reconciliation and first Communion.
