Next weekend is the collection for the Retired Priests fund. Priests do not usually have a large enough income to pay for a rest home and so the diocese will pick up the bill to give the appropriate care. It is the biggest outlay as many priests worked from the 60s onward, often coming over from Ireland, and are now reaching their final days. The parish donations will make their lives more comfortable. There are donation envelopes in the narthex by the children's books and donations made using the contactless devices will be given to the appeal

if the donation was more than 40 minutes after the end of mass.

The Marriage and Family Life offer several courses and weekends on married Life and bereavement. More details are on the board.

The GDPR legislation allows us to keep personal records for no more than five years although Churches can keep registers of Sacraments including Baptism, Confirmation, Marriage and the deceased. We keep records of first Communion too.

From next week, in February and March up until Easter there will be the opportunity to complete a census form. This is important as a record of living in the parish and practising here. It was very useful after Covid to invite people back to the parish mass in the Church thanks to your generosity in putting the cards through the doors. They are not obligatory but a good means to keep in contact.

For children I would be grateful if the current year group was added, so those in year 2 can be invited to receive the sacraments of Reconciliation and first Communion.
